The Eiger by Gfeller Telecommunications.

A strikingly attractive one-piece press-button telephone, the Eiger incorporates a 'memory button' which when pressed automatically recalls the last number called, very useful for those often engaged numbers.

It has a textured finish and is available in red, stone or two-tone brown. A dark grey version is also

available for business users where PBX recall is required.

The Eiger can be used as a main telephone or on most extensions including PBX extensions. The Eiger is not suitable for use on shared exchange lines.
